

Tabletop Fixture Double

- Lay out all fixture pieces onto a COMPLETELY FLAT surface. *Doing this on an uneven surface may produce breaks in the melamine. Pound in all clips using the mallet and clip holder provided.
 *Hold the clip holder straight up and down. Make sure all clips are open. Place glue into each shelf cut, insert plexi glass, and leave to dry.
- 2. Lay A (Left Side) on the floor, holes facing up.
- **3.** Insert C (Back) into A (Left Side). Clips should be facing the back of the fixture. Close the connected clips.
- **4.** Insert E (Top) into A (Left Side). Clips should be facing the top of the fixture. The hole should be positioned in the front, left corner of the fixture. Leave the clips open, for now.
- **5.** Insert D (Ad Panel), **edge banded side facing down**, into A (Left Side). Clips should be facing the back of the fixture. Close the connected clips. Close E's connected clips, now.
- **6.** Insert F (Deck), edge banded side facing the front of the fixture, into A (Left Side). Clips should be facing the bottom of the fixture. Leave the clips open, for now.
- 7. Insert G (Toe Kick), edge banded side facing down, into A (Left Side). Clips should be facing the back of the fixture. Close the connected clips. Close F's connected clips, now.
- 8. Set B (Right Side) onto the fixture. Work from the top of the fixture to the bottom to line up all holes.

 *The rubber mallet is helpful for this. While holding pressure down on B (Right Side), close connected clips.
- **9.** Insert C(T) (Tabletop Back) into B (Right Side). Clips should be facing the back of the fixture. Close the connected clips.
- **10.** Insert F(T) (Tabletop Deck), **edge banded side facing the front of the fixture**, into B (Right Side). Clips should be facing the bottom of the fixture. Leave the clips open, for now.
- **11.** Insert G(T) (Tabletop Toe Kick), **edge banded side facing down**, into B (Right Side). Clips should be facing the back of the fixture. Close the connected clips. Close F(T)'s connected clips, now.
- **12.** Insert E(T) (Tabletop Top) into B (Right Side). Clips should be facing the bottom of the fixture. Leave the clips open, for now.
- 13. Set A(R) (Left Side 2) onto the fixture. Work from the top of the fixture to the bottom to line up all holes. *The rubber mallet is helpful for this. While holding pressure down on A(R) (Right Side 2), close connected clips. *Hold the top end of A(R) (Left Side 2) steady during this step.
- **14.** Repeat steps 3 through 8 for the right slatwall fixture, using pieces: C(R) (Back 2), E(R) (Top 2), D(R) (Ad Panel 2), F(R) (Deck 2), G(R) (Toe Kick 2), and B(R) (Right Side 2).
- 15. Double check that ALL clips are closed.
- 16. Roll the fixture onto its back.
- 17. Set the slatwalls into place. *Putting a plastic insert into the very bottom, between the slatwall and F (Deck), is helpful for lining it up correctly.
- 18. Screw the slatwalls into place, lining screws into slat grooves. *We recommend using 1" sheetrock screws.
- 19. Insert all plastic slatwall inserts. *The lip of the insert should face the top of the fixture (see image on other side). Apply feet to the fixture. Mount LED lighting if provided.
- 20. Stand the fixture up, place shelves, & enjoy
